

## Stormwater / Clean Water NJ TIPS:

### Vehicles & Garage

Your everyday activities can affect water quality. Help reduce the amount of pollution that flows into our waterways by following the tips below.

- Take your car to a service center to change oil or antifreeze. **If** you do change your own oil or antifreeze, do it in a garage, never on the street.
- Use a self-contained oil pan and recycle the oil properly at a local service center or municipal recycling facility.
- If you spill hazardous fluids, contain it immediately with rags or cat litter. Clean up the spill and properly dispose of the waste.
- Check your car for leaks and schedule regular tune-ups. If you find leaks or drips, have your car repaired.
- Store hazardous materials properly to prevent spills. Store them in the original closed container.

## IS YOUR DOG AND OR CAT REGISTERED AND LICENSED

\$10.00 LATE FEE BEGINS MAY 1, 2020

**Proof of Rabies vaccination required and  
 must not expire before September 30, 2020.**  
**Dogs \$15.00    \$12.00 if neutered/ spayed**  
**Cats \$ 5.00    \$ 2.00 if neutered/ spayed**

- **Limit your use of fertilizers and pesticides**
  - Do a soil test to see if you need a fertilizer.
  - Do not apply fertilizers if heavy rain is predicted.
  - Look into alternatives for pesticides.
  - Maintain a small lawn and keep the rest of your property or yard in a natural state with trees and other native vegetation that requires little or no fertilizer.
  - If you use fertilizers and pesticides, follow the instructions on the label on how to correctly apply it. Make sure you properly store or discard any unused portions.
