2014 Budget

The Township Committee discussed the 2014 Budget and was satisfied with the numbers provided by the Chief Finance Officer.

Capital Items

The Public Works Department had a list of vehicles and equipment they would like to purchase. Dump Truck / snow plow, Heating Units (Leisure Arms), 4 door pickup w/ snow plow, hot water pressure washer for wash bay, sewer pumps, roof repairs at garage and expand and place doors on wash bay; for a total of 310,000.00

The Fire Department would like a new Fire Truck at a cost of between 450,000.000 to 500,000.00, siting that a truck will be 25 years old in a few years an needs replacing.

The Committee discussed these items and will get some more information and revisit these items at the next Budget Meeting on March 11.
