





Dog and Cat Licenses should be renewed during January. The animals Rabies vaccination must not expire before September 1, 2012, or you must get the animal a three-year Rabies booster before getting the 2012 license.

Residents can obtain the License at the Municipal Building weekdays from 8:00 am – 4:30 pm

Dog License Fees for 2012

State fee	\$ 1.20

If the animal is not fixed an additional fee of \$3.00 applies.
