

Although most years of the modern calendar have 365 days, a complete revolution around the sun takes approximately 365 days, 5 hours, 49 minutes, and 16 seconds. Every four years, during which an extra 24 hours have accumulated, one extra day is added to keep the count coordinated with the sun's apparent position. To compensate for the difference, an end-of-century year is not a leap year unless it is also [exactly divisible by 400](#). This means that the years 1600 and 2000 were leap years, 1800 and 1900 were not, nor will be 2100, 2200 and 2300.
