

Earlier this year the Township Committee authorized the purchase of two waste oil heaters to be installed at the Public Works Garage. These units cost about \$4700 each, and are expected to last for many years. Since early May, we have collected approximately 1800 gallons of waste oil. We had previously sold this waste oil to a recycler for about 10 cents per gallon. Assuming a heating oil price of \$3 per

gallon, this represents about \$5,400 saved in heating costs so far. One of these units has paid for itself already. Great job to the Public Works Department for suggesting, installing, and implementing this idea! This example also demonstrates the Township Committees ongoing efforts to maximize the value of the money we spend. Keep the ideas coming, and be sure to bring all your waste oil to the recycling facility!
