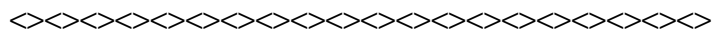

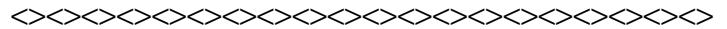
LAC AMBULANCE SQUAD is looking
