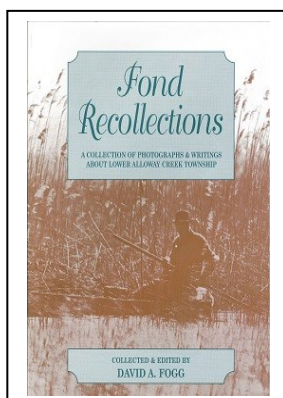

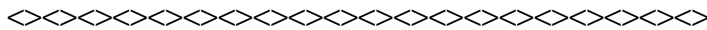

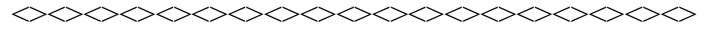

RESIDENTS ARE REMINDED THAT OPEN FIRES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN NJ EXCEPT WHEN A BURN PERMIT IS SECURED

Prohibited Fires or Open Burning Under "Control and Prohibition of Open Burning" N.J.A.C. 7:27—2.1 et seq.

Salvage operations by open burning (7:27-2.2). The disposal of rubbish, garbage, trade waste, buildings or structures by open burning (7:27-2.3A). The disposal of fallen leaves by open burning (7:27-2.3B). Transfer of permits issued from one location to another or from one person to another.

Under New Jersey Forest Fire Law - N.J.S.A Title 13:9 Setting fire to any forest, brush, grassland or tidal marsh without the written permission of a Forest Firewarden (13:9-19).

Having any fire by which property may be endangered without maintaining a careful and competent watch (13:9-20).

Violations may result in fines to \$5,000 and reimbursement of costs associated with extinguishing the fire!
