New Low-Cost Broadband at Home
and Computer Offerings

JerseyOn, a new state-wide nonprofit
focused on connecting low-income
students and their families to high speed
Internet, by delivering access to high-
speed, low-cost home Internet, affordable
computers, and digital literacy training
for the thousands of unconnected people
in our state.

Through partnerships with local
Internet service providers, JerseyOn is
able to offer high-speed Internet access to
low-income students and their families.
In LAC, we will be working with
FreedomPop, which rides on the Sprint
network, and Comcast. For \$39.98,
families will be able to purchase a
hotspot-like device that comes with a
lifetime of 1GB of data a month with no
fees.

Qualifications

Anyone can qualify for JerseyOn offers
regardless of their credit history, past due
balances, lost equipment, and/or if they
are currently using another broadband
