**Mayor's Memo**

Hello Everyone,

I hope summer is treating everyone well so far. I have just a couple items to discuss this month. I don't know about you, but my recycle can was very full a couple weeks ago. What we had discovered a while ago is that since we pick up recyclables on the second and fourth Tuesdays, about three times a year there is a three week gap between pickups in each town. We have already reached agreement with Mannington and Elsinboro to change the pickup schedule to every other week beginning next year. The delay is because we had already set the calendars for 2013 and mailed them to our residents. As always, the convenience center is open Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings if you find yourself a little too full to last until the next scheduled pickup.

Next, the Township Committee recently approved a pilot program to allow the CFO and Township Clerk to work four ten hour days per week in July and August. This will allow us to close the building on Fridays. There has been virtually no pedestrian traffic in the building on Fridays this year. We will measure if this is successful in reducing energy costs with the air conditioning and lighting, and if this creates any hardship on the residents. The core hours to be covered are Monday thru Thursday 8 am thru 4:30 pm. This means the folks may work as early as 6 am until 4:30 pm or as late as 8 am until 6 pm, just so long as the core hours are covered. As always, please provide feedback and we will adjust as necessary.

Have a great summer everyone and keep those cost saving ideas coming. We'll try them if we can!
