Mayor's Memo

Hello Everyone and Happy March.

The solar project is finally underway again. There were several delays getting started. Atlantic City Electric and the BPU took almost a year to approve applications. When this was finally overcome, the vendor began erecting the support foundations last summer. Shortly thereafter his home in Fortescue was completely destroyed by Superstorm Sandy. Now there has been a delay in delivery of the panels themselves, and with Atlantic City Electric completing the transformer upgrades. That being said, we are finally underway again and the vendor assures us we have his undivided attention. The Leisure Arms Community Center should be on line by the time you read this, and they will move right on around until they are completed. The incentive is with the vendor to get this done, as he has spent hundreds of thousands of dollars and he doesn't start making any money until the systems begin producing electricity.

The Alloways Creek Bank Stabilization Project is well underway. Contrary to what has been reported in the newspaper, the bank height will NOT be raised. The state would not let us raise it. It will remain at the same elevation. Significant erosion and undermining has been found and addressed during this project. The recent storms and high tides remind us of the importance of this creek bank. During Superstorm Sandy, the creek was within a foot of overflowing, and in the high tides a few weeks later, the water was equal to the bank height. To put this in perspective, Front street is an average of 3 feet lower than the creek bank. All of Hancocks Bridge would be underwater if this bank were to fail. Efforts are underway to obtain the permits to complete the last 500 feet that remain undone.

Township Residents

“The L.A.C. Police Department is requesting that resident’s install, repair, or replace numbers that identify their addresses.

There are emergency calls where responding Officers drive past or cannot find the correct address. If no numbers are present, it will take longer for an Officer and Emergency Services to arrive at your location”.

House or building numbers shall be:

- A. In Arabic numerals and light-reflective.
- B. A minimum height of **three (3) inches**.
- C. Mounted in a secure fashion to the front wall or porch of the building or other fixed appurtenance in the front of the building so as to be clearly visible from the street.
- D. Sufficiently legible as to contrasting background, arrangement, spacing and uniformity so as to **be clearly visible from the street**.
- E. **At least thirty (30) inches, but no more than fifteen (15) feet, above ground level** and so placed that trees, shrubs and other obstructions do not block the line of sight of the numbers from the street upon which the house or building fronts.
