**From Public Safety Director David Sowers**

The Police Department is now operating under a shared services agreement with Salem County Emergency Services for Police dispatching.

The Historical Police telephone number used for non-emergency purposes has been 935-7300, which, will now be answered by Salem County Dispatchers in Mannington. The County will then contact patrolling Officers by radio and they will immediately respond to provide Police Services as always.



There is no change to the 911 Emergency Response System. The County has always answered 911 calls.

In addition, the Police Department will maintain a business line at 935-7301 for non-emergency Police business. This line will be answered at the Police Department from 8 am to 4 pm on Weekdays (Monday thru Friday). On nights (4 pm thru 8 am) and weekends, the 935-7301 line will provide recorded prompts for leaving messages.

In addition, a **RED** telephone Box has been installed outside the main entrance to the Police Department. For Police assistance any time, 24/7, anyone can lift the receiver and speak directly to a Police Dispatcher.




