ABOUT THE CABIN

Although the date of the original construction is unknown, our cabin has been restored and reconstructed in much the same manner as local Ouakers would have lived in the 1700's. Because the air had deteriorated so many of the logs, it was impossible to save the entire original structure. All the wood used in the reconstruction of this cabin came from the woods in Lower Alloways Creek that are owned by the Township. The hand-hewn logs are white oak. The wide floor boards are pine. The fireplace and foundation were built from Jersey sandstone that had been donated by John Hassler. The four field stones that were found under the foundation are original; also original are the doors and windows. To ensure that reconstruction was as authentic as possible, mortar used between the logs was made from field clay and cattail.
