Payments for the 2020–2021 tax quarters may be made via:

- Mail a check via United States Postal Service
- Drop a check or money order in locked box located in the foyer, inside the front door, of Municipal Building

RECYCLING GUIDELINE

Please **ONLY** recycle bottle-grade plastics (numbered 1 and 2), LOOK FOR THE SYMBOL



PET [Polyethylene terephthalate](#)

Typically: Plastic soft drink, water, sports drink, beer, mouthwash, catsup and salad dressing bottles. Peanut butter, pickle, jelly and jam jars.



HDPE [High density polyethylene](#)

Typically: Milk, water, juice, cosmetic, shampoo, dish and laundry detergent bottles.

ALONG WITH steel, tin, aluminum, glass, newspapers, magazines, cartons, clean cardboard and other paper



DO NOT, DEFINITELY NOT, NOT AT ALL, BY NO MEANS, NO WAY PUT OUT WITH RECYCLABLES

(these are trash)

EMPTY MOTOR OIL CONTAINERS, ANTI-FREEZE CONTAINERS, OR ANY PRODUCT WITH A RECYCLING SYMBOL OTHER THAN THE TWO ACCEPTABLE ONES ABOVE

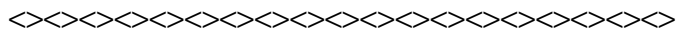

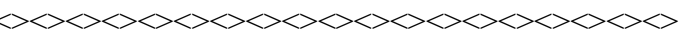
