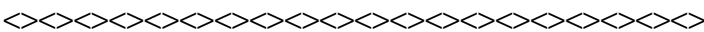

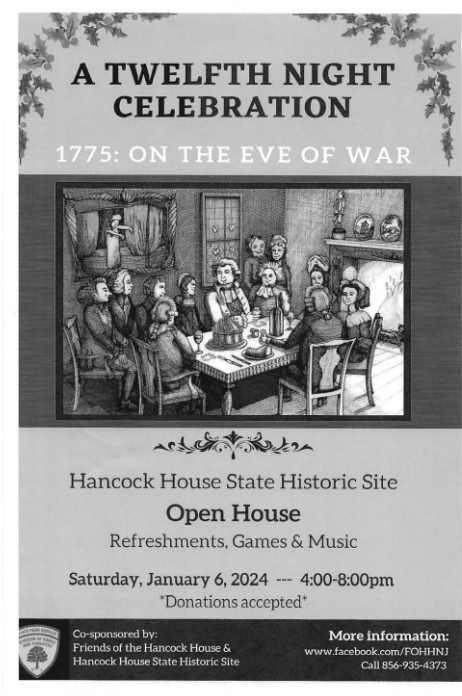
Michelle Allen, who served as the Tax
