LEISURE ARMS SENIOR COMPLEX
NEW ALTERNATE LIST AND REQUIREMENTS

THE OLD LEISURE ARMS WAITING LIST WILL
NOW BE CALLED THE PRIORITY LIST AND A
NEW ALTERNATE LIST HAS BEEN APPROVED.

The PRIORITY LIST requirements remain the same in
that a resident is eligible to be placed on the list if they are
currently now living in the Township and have lived
continuously in the Township for the past TEN (10) years
without a break and are at least SIX-FIVE (65) years old.

The new ALTERNATE LIST will be used if no one
from the Priority List accepts a unit when one is available.

The Alternate List rules are as follows:

Must have been a resident of the Township continuously
for the past one (1) full year without a break and must
have been a resident of the Township for a minimum of
ten (10) years prior to any break in residency.

THE PERSON APPLING FOR EITHER LIST IS
RESPONSIBLE TO PROVIDE PROOF OF
RESIDENCY IN THE FORM OF PROPERTY TAX
BILL, RENTAL AGREEMENT, DEED, CONTRACT
OF SALE, DRIVER’S LICENSE, UTILITY BILL,
VOTER OR CAR REGISTRATION CARD
